Degree information

You will complete 24 courses (72 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 8 courses (24 units) at Level I and at least 10 courses (30 units) at Level II and 6 courses (18 units) at Level III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units

The Bachelor of Environmental Policy and Management requires completion of core courses, Environmental Policy and Management closed electives, a minor, and open electives.

Geography, Environment & Population Courses
