Degree information

You will complete 30 courses (96 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 8 courses (24 units) at Level I and at least 24 courses (72 units) at Levels II and III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units.

The Bachelor of International Studies requires completion of core courses, International Studies closed electives, and open elective courses. There are four core courses (15 units), and five International Studies closed electives (15 units) which you must choose from a specific list.

Students must also complete a minimum of three courses (9 units) in Language Studies (6 units of Language at Level I, and 3 units of Culture at Level II).

*Exemption: International students, students studying a diploma in languages or a language major or minor in another degree are exempt from completing the mandatory language component, although may complete language units in a different language if they wish. Students who are exempt from language study must complete International Studies closed electives instead. These can be selected from any stream.

^Language Level II: if you wish to only study the mandatory 9 units of language, you must enrol in a Culture Level II course in semester 1 of second year. If you wish to continue your language studies to achieve a second minor, please check the minor of your particular language at www.arts.adelaide.edu.au/current-students/undergrad/majorsminors/

The Bachelor of Arts requires completion of one major and elective courses. A minor is not required in a double degree, but you can choose to study a minor. Non-Arts majors are not permitted in a double degree. You can access closed elective and major/minor lists at:
