Degree information

You will complete 24 courses (72 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 8 courses (24 units) at Level I and at least 16 courses (48 units) at Levels II and III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units.

The Bachelor of Languages requires a minimum of one extended major (30 units), one minor (18 units), the Level I foundation course ARTS 1007 (3 units), and open elective courses (21 unit). Students can elect to study a second major of 24 units in lieu of a minor.

The Extended Major

Your major comprises ten courses (30 units) from the same language. This includes the standard language major, plus two additional courses known as cognates.

Students studying French Studies, German Studies, Italian Studies, Modern Greek Studies and Spanish Studies must complete the additional culture courses available in their chosen language (refer to the European Languages Cognate List). Students studying Chinese Studies, Japanese Studies, or Indonesian Studies can select alternate courses (refer to the Asian Language Sequence Cognate List).

The Second Major

Your second major comprises eight courses (24 units) and must be chosen from another language or Linguistics. No more than two Level I courses (6 units) can count towards the major.
