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### Degree information

You will complete up to 23 courses (72 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 8 courses (24 units) at Level I and at least 16 courses (48 units) at Levels II and III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units.

The Bachelor of Social Sciences requires completion of core courses, Social Sciences closed electives, and broadening electives.

### Social Sciences Courses

There are eight core courses (27 units) that you must complete for your degree. There are also up to four closed electives (12 units) which you must choose from a specific list.
