

THE BARONY OF ITHAKA GOLD MEDAL FOR EXCELLENCE IN GREEK CULTURAL STUDIES

Background

In 1995 Mr Nicholas C Galatis gave \$3,000 to the University for the purpose of encouraging the study of Greek and Byzantine studies through the provision of an annual lecture and prizes.

Rules

- 1. There shall be an annual prize called "The Barony of Ithaka Gold Medal for Excellence in Greek Cultural Studies".
- 2. The prize shall be a gold medal and a book voucher of \$75, unless otherwise determined by the Faculty.
- 3. The prize shall be awarded each year at the Galatis Prize Giving Ceremony.
- 4. The prize shall be awarded to the most meritorious student in an Upper level Greek Cultural Studies course.
- 5. If, in any particular year, the examiner/s consider that no candidate is suitable for the prize, then no award shall be made.
- 6. If two or more candidates are deemed to be of equal merit, the prize shall be awarded to each candidate.
