

THE CONSTANTINE TRYPANIS PRIZE

Background

In 1981, Mr B Konstas, proprietor of the Greek News, generously provided an endowment to be used to fund an annual prize for outstanding students studying Modern Greek, in memory of Professor Trypanis.

Rules

- 1. The prize shall be called "The Constantine Trypanis Prize".
- 2. The value of the prize shall be \$750.
- 3. The prize shall be awarded annually to the student who, in the opinion of the examiner, is the most outstanding Level III student in Modern Greek Studies.
- 4. If, in any particular year, there is no candidate suitable for the prize, then no award shall be made.
- 5. If two or more candidates are of equal merit the prize shall be divided equally amongst those candidates.
- 6. These rules may be varied from time to time by the Faculty of Arts, but the title and purpose of the prize shall not be changed.
