Degree information

You will complete 32 courses (96 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 8 courses (24 units) at Level I and at least 24 courses (72 units) at Levels II and III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units.

The Bachelor of Arts requires completion of one major (24 units) and Arts elective courses (21 units). A minor is not required in a double degree, but you can choose to study a minor. Non-Arts majors are not permitted in a double degree.

The Arts Major

A major comprises up to eight courses (24 units) from one area of study. You must complete at least 3 units (and a maximum of 6 units) at Level I, at least 3 units at Level II, and at least 12 units at Level III including the designated 6-unit capstone course. For a major in languages you must complete a maximum of 6 units at Level I, a maximum of 9 units at Level II and a maximum of 9 units at Level III.
