## Degree information

You will complete 72 units for the degree, comprising at least 12 units (and a maximum of 24 units) at Level I, and a minimum of 48 units at Levels II and III - with at least 18 units at Level III. Most courses are worth 3 units, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units. The Bachelor of Arts requires completion of:

- Not more than 24 units at Level I
- the core course: ARTS 1007 The Enquiring Mind: Freedom and Media
- at least one Arts major to the value of 24 units
- a minor in Arts, or in Economics, International Business, Management or Marketing to the value of 18 units, or Psychology to the value of 21 units
- 27 units of electives (including 9 units of broadening)

You can elect to complete a second major from Arts or in Economics, International Business, Management or Marketing to the value of 24 units. If you complete a second major, you do not need to complete a minor.

## The Major

A major comprises up to eight courses (24 units) from one area of study. You must complete at least 3 units (and a maximum of 6 units) at Level I, at least 3 units at Level II, and at least 12 units at Level III including the designated 6-unit capstone course. For a major in languages you must complete a maximum of 6 units at Level I, a maximum of 9 units at Level II and a maximum of 9 units at Level III.

## The Minor

A minor comprises six courses (18 units) from the same area of study. Where pathways are not structured otherwise, you must complete at least 3 units (and a maximum of 6 units) at Level I, a minimum of 3 units and a maximum of 6 units at Level II, 6 units at Level III (the capstone is not available in the minor).

## Electives & Broadening

You will complete nine elective courses (27 units). Of these courses:

- A maximum of eight courses (24 units) can be chosen from other Faculties of the University. All remaining electives must be chosen from disciplines within the Faculty of Arts
- At least three courses (9 units) must be from outside your major and minor areas. These are known as broadening electives. Students who complete a second major are exempt from this requirement (unless the majors are designated to be cognate – [arts.adelaide.edu.au/current-students/undergrad/](https://arts.adelaide.edu.au/current-students/undergrad/)).
