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### Degree information

You will complete 23 courses (72 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 8 courses (24 units) at Level I and at least 16 courses (48 units) at level II or III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units.

The Bachelor of Criminology requires completion of core courses, Criminology closed electives, broadening and Arts electives.

### Criminology Courses

There are eight core courses (27 units) that you must complete for your degree. There are also four Criminology closed elective courses (12 units), which you must choose from a specific list. You can access the closed elective list at:
