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Degree information

You will complete 23 courses (72 units) to finish your degree, with not more than 11 courses (33 units) at Level I, and at least 18 units at Level III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Advanced Level courses which are worth 6 units. The Bachelor of Liberal Arts and Sciences requires completion of eight core courses (27 units), Arts and Sciences electives, and open electives.

Electives Courses

You will complete fifteen elective courses (45 units) of which:

- six courses (18 units) must be chosen from the Faculty of Sciences*
- six courses (18 units) must be chosen from the Faculty of Arts
- three courses are open electives (9 units) which can be chosen from any faculty in the University. Electives can be chosen from the same or different areas of study.

You can decide how to arrange your electives provided that you meet the above requirements of the minimum courses required in each area, e.g. you may decide to study 3 x Arts electives at Level I and 3 x Arts electives at Level II. *Students are **STRONGLY** advised to seek advice from the Faculty of Sciences Office when choosing Level I Sciences courses.
