### Structure of Your Degree

You will complete 72 units to finish your degree, comprising at least 12 units (and a maximum of 30 units) at Level I, and a minimum of 24 units at Level III. Most courses are worth 3 units each, except some Level III courses which are worth 6 units.

The Bachelor of Music requires completion of:

- Not more than 30 units at Level I
- the core course: ARTS 1007 The Enquiring Mind: Freedom and Media
- a minimum of 24 units at Level III
- 9 units of broadening electives

### Music Electives & Broadening

You will complete five elective courses (15 units). Of these courses:

- At least three courses (9 units) must be from outside the music discipline. These are known as broadening electives.
- All remaining electives must be chosen from the music discipline.
