### Why study a Master of Teaching?

If you've already completed an approved undergraduate degree, our Master of Teaching offers a unique pathway to a rewarding career.

Our program is for people who already have a degree specialising in subjects relevant to middle and secondary school teaching (years 7 - 12).

The Master of Teaching is a 48 unit (two year) program offered in accelerated mode (1.5 years). Fees are based on the number of units you enrol in.

### Why study at the University of Adelaide?

Our staff have practical teaching experience, and our small class sizes mean you get personal attention to maximise your potential. You will become part of a community of learners, who go on to become your professional network of colleagues.

You will have access to great job opportunities through our extensive network of industry partners who specialise in the middle and secondary years. We collaborate with our partners in teaching, learning and research to make sure you emerge job-ready when you graduate.

You will enter your future career with an ePortfolio that is ready to use as you step into the classroom.

### eLearning Program

Develop your digital capabilities in our eLearning Program – the first and only one of its kind for Education students in Australia. Use your own iPad with pencil and keyboard to its full teaching potential to earn Apple Teacher status.

### Professional Experience

Practical experience in a school setting is vital to develop your teaching skills. You will have two blocks of 25 days in your first year, and one block of 20 days in your second year. Placements are taken on a full-time continuous basis.

\*The ability to read music is essential.

### Professional Accreditation

This program is accredited by the Teachers Registration Board of South Australia. Graduates may register to teach in South Australia, and in most cases interstate and overseas.

### Entry Requirements

To apply, you'll need:

- a Bachelor degree or equivalent from a recognised Australian or international higher education institution.
- a major and minor teaching area (or specialisation) which aligns with the Australian Curriculum and/or the South Australian senior secondary curriculum, the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE).
- to satisfy the AITSL non-academic entry requirements of the Teaching Capabilities Statement which explains your motivation to become a teacher.

### Additional Requirements

During the degree, you will also need:

- the Child Protection Curriculum
- an approved Responding to Abuse and Neglect course
- Working With Children Check (WWCC) before placement
- the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE).
