Compulsory Course

Environment Policy and Management Course

You must complete 24 units of Core courses, and 12 units of Environmental Policy and Management Closed Elective courses from the list on page 2. Ensure that you check any restrictions and pre-requisites.

The Minor

You must complete a minor of 18 units as part of this degree. No more than 6 units of Level I courses can count towards the minor.

You can undertake a minor in one of the following disciplines:

Anthropology, Art History and Visual Culture, Asian Studies, Chinese Studies, Classics, Creative Writing, Criminology, English, French Studies, Gender Studies, German Studies, History, Indigenous Knowledges and Society, Indonesian Studies, International Development, Italian Studies, Japanese Studies, Linguistics, Modern Greek Studies, Music, Philosophy, Politics and International Studies, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish Studies.
