Degree information

You must complete 72 units for the degree, comprising at least 12 units (and a maximum of 24 units) at Level I, and a minimum of 48 units at Levels II and III with at least 18 units at Level III. Courses are worth 3 units each, unless specified otherwise

Compulsory Course

You must complete 12 units of compulsory courses as follows:

- ARTS 1008 The Enquiring Mind Arts Advanced
- ARTS 3003 Advanced Humanities: Theory and Method
- ARTS 3002 Advanced Arts Research Project

Major 1

In addition to the Psychology major, you must complete a second major from the areas listed below. The major must include ARTS 3002 (replacing designated capstone, unless studying a language major):

Art History and Visual Culture, Anthropology, Asian Studies, Australian Studies, Chinese Studies, Classics, Creative Writing, Criminology, Cultural Studies, Digital Humanities, Economics, Education, English, Film Studies, French Studies, Gender Studies, Geography, Environment and Population, German Studies, History, Indigenous Knowledges and Society, Indonesian Studies, International Development, Italian Studies, Japanese Studies, Linguistics, Mathematical Sciences, Media, Modern Greek Studies, Music, Philosophy, Politics and International Relations, Sociology, Spanish Studies.

For non-language majors you must complete:

- At least 3 units (and a maximum of 6 units) at Level I
- At least 3 units at Level II, and
- At least 6 units at Level III
- ARTS 3002 Advanced Arts Research Project in non-language major

For a major in languages you must complete:

- A maximum of 6 units at Level I
- A maximum of 9 units at Level II, and
- A maximum of 9 units at Level III.

Level II and III Prerequisites

Level II and III course prerequisites are waived for this program, allowing advanced courses to be taken from first year. It is recommended that a minimum of 12 units of Level I courses be successfully completed first. The prerequisite for capstone courses must be observed.

Elective

You must complete 9 units of elective courses. Electives can be from the same or different areas of study. Ensure that you check any restrictions and pre-requisites.
