

Marnie Cowan Scholarship Application

The Cowan Grant was established in 1994 as a charitable trust providing financial help to tertiary students in accordance with the wishes of the late Mrs A.M. (Marnie) Cowan and her husband W.A. (Bill) Cowan of Adelaide. Each year, the Trustees will generously provide one or more scholarships to support needy students at the Elder Conservatorium of Music.

- Students may be enrolled in Conservatorium programs at any level – Undergraduate or Postgraduate.
- Applicants will be assessed according to academic merit and will be in receipt of a government benefit based on financial need or a demonstrated alternative.
- Applications must include: documentary evidence of financial need, such as income tested Commonwealth income support payment, such as Youth Allowance, Austudy, ABSTUDY benefits, or other details of financial circumstances.

Applications close Semester 1: Jan 31st or Semester 2: 31st August. Late applications will not be considered. A selection committee will consider all applications and notify applicants of the outcome early in the semester.
