

The Department of Spanish Studies Prize Rules

Establishment

This Prize has been established by a donation to the University by Dr Jorge Paredes, Head of Spanish Studies at the University of Adelaide. Dr Paredes will fund the prize for 5 years (2018-2022).

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Prize, students must have completed Spanish IIIA and IIIB Language in the given year and be either:-

- completing a Bachelor degree within the Faculty of Arts; or
- completing a Diploma in Languages – Spanish.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of Spanish Studies (or his/her nominee) will award the Prize to the eligible student with the highest GPA across all Spanish courses who has made a positive contribution to the Department of Spanish Studies.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in any given year then the prize will not be awarded.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize may be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and policies.
