Degree Information

You must complete 72 units to finish your degree, comprising at least 12 units (and a maximum of 24 units) at Level I, and a minimum of 24 units at Level III. Courses are worth 3 units each, unless specified.

Compulsory Course

You must complete ARTS 1007/OL The Enquiring Mind.

Advanced Course

You must complete 9 units of Advanced courses.

Core Course

You must complete 51 units of Core courses.

*These courses must be undertaken in consecutive semesters/years. Any student who is not enrolled in a Classical Performance course for one year or more will need to re-audition before recommencing the next level.

^Students can only enrol into these courses after attending an audition, usually held during orientation. Students will be placed in TWO of the following components:
