You must complete one major comprising at least 24 units of study as follows:

- At least 3 units (and a maximum of 6 units) at Level I,

- 6-unit capstone course.

For a major in languages you must complete:

- A maximum of 6 units at Level I,
- A maximum of 9 units at Level II and
- A maximum of 9 units at Level III.

[^] Defined by the accrediting body, Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL):

i) **A major teaching area** is the equivalent of a total of three-quarters of a year's full time study which equates to 18 units. No more than 6 units at Level I and at least 6 units at Level III can be counted.

ii) **A minor teaching area** is equivalent to one-half year of full time study which equates to 12 units. No more than 6 units at Level I can be counted.

Teaching Area 2 (Arts Minor)

You must complete one minor in a different area of study to your major, comprising at least 18 units. Where pathways are not structured, you must complete:

- At least 3 units and a maximum of 6 units at Level I,
- A minimum of 3 units and a maximum of 6 units at Level II
- A maximum of 6 units at Level III (6-unit capstone not available)
