Arts Major

For a major in languages you must complete 24 units comprising:

- A maximum of 6 units at Level I,
- A maximum of 9 units at Level II and
- A maximum of 9 units at Level III. (ARTS 3002 Advanced Research Project substitutes the 3 units at level III).

A minor is not required in a double degree.

You can undertake an Arts major in the following areas of study: Anthropology, Art History and Visual Culture, Australian Studies, Chinese Studies, Classics, Creative Writing, Criminology, Cultural Studies, Digital Humanities, Economics, Education, English, Film Studies, French Studies, Gender Studies, Geography, Environment & Population, German Studies, History, Indigenous Knowledges & Society, International Development, Italian Studies, Japanese Studies, Linguistics, Mathematical Sciences, Media, Modern Greek Studies, Music, Philosophy, Politics & International Relations, Sociology, Spanish Studies.
