Degree Information

You must complete 72 units to finish your degree, comprising at least 12 units (and a maximum of 30 units) at Level I, and a minimum of 24 units at Level III. Courses are worth 3 units each, unless specified.

Compulsory Course

You must complete ARTS 1007/OL The Enquiring Mind.

Core Course

You must complete 51 units of Core courses.

*These courses must be undertaken in consecutive semesters/years. Any student who is not enrolled in a Music Education Performance course for one year or more will need to re-audition before recommencing the next level. You will be placed in ONE of the following components:

Electives

You must complete 18 units of electives comprising:

- 9 units of broadening electives chosen from outside the music discipline (with the exception of Music Internships or Music Study Tours, which can contribute to 3 units of broadening electives).
- 9 units of electives can be chosen from music or any area of study. **Please note:** if you wish to be a classroom teacher, you must use this elective space to study a second teaching area outside music.
