### Social Sciences Course

You must complete 27 units of Social Sciences Core courses and 12 units of Social Sciences Closed Electives.

### Psychology Minor

The Psychology minor comprises 21 units of Psychology courses including 9 units at Level I, 6 units at Level II, and 6 units at Level III.

**Please Note:** the minimum requirement for entry into Honours in Psychology is a 33-unit major in psychology. A minor in psychology is not accredited by the Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC) and will not lead to the Honours year.
