Degree Information

Compulsory Language Course

You must complete a minimum of 9 units in Language Studies as follows:

- 6 units of Language at Level I, and
- 3 units of Language or Culture at Level II.

You can choose a language from the following: *Chinese Studies, French Studies, German Studies, Indonesian Studies, Italian Studies, Japanese Studies, Modern Greek Studies or Spanish Studies.*

*You are exempt from completing this language component if:

- You are an International student
- You are studying a Diploma in Languages, or
- You are studying a language major/minor in another degree

Students who are exempt from language study must complete International Relations closed electives or a different language.

Electives

You must complete 9 units of elective courses (or 0 units if undertaking optional language minor). Electives can be from different subject areas.
