<sup>^</sup> Defined by the accrediting body, Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL):

i) A **major teaching area** is the equivalent of a total of three-quarters of a year's full time study which equates to 18 units. No more than 6 units at Level I and at least 6 units at Level III can be counted.

A **minor teaching area** is equivalent to one-half year of full time study which equates to 12 units. No more than 6 units at Level I can be counted.
