

The Most Outstanding Gender Studies Student Level II Prize

Rules

The School of Social Sciences has established the following prizes within their Department of Sociology, Criminology and Gender Studies to award the most outstanding student/s in second year gender studies.

The following Rules now apply:-

Title

The prize shall be called the “The Most Outstanding Gender Studies Student Level II Prize.”

Value

The prize shall comprise a medal.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Prize, candidates must be undertaking all second year Gender Studies (GEND) subjects in the year for which the Prize is awarded.

Selection of Candidate

The Course Conveners shall award the prize to the candidate who achieves the highest average marks across the second year Gender Studies (GEND) courses.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in any given year then the Prize will not be awarded in that year.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then multiple prizes may be awarded.
