- GEOG (Geography, Environment and Population)
- HIST (History)
- POLIS (Politics and International Relations)
- Courses with the subject area of your minor discipline.

Ensure that you check any restrictions and prerequisites.

You will complete a minor of 18 units from one of the following disciplines:

- Anthropology
- Asian Studies
- Chinese Studies
- French Studies
- Gender Studies
- Geography, Environment and Population
- History
- Indigenous Knowledges and Society
- Indonesian Studies
- Japanese Studies
- Politics and International Relations
- Spanish Studies.

No more than 6 units of Level I courses can count towards the minor.
