Degree information

You must complete 72 units to finish your degree, with not more than 33 units at Level I, and at least 18 units at Level III. You must complete 39 units of Arts, Sciences and open electives. Most courses are worth 3 units each, unless specified otherwise.

Compulsory Course

You must complete ARTS 1007/OL The Enquiring Mind.

Liberal Arts and Science Course

You must complete 30 units of Liberal Arts and Sciences courses.

Elective Courses

You must complete 39 units of elective courses comprising:

- 18 units must be chosen from the Faculty of Sciences*
- 18 units must be chosen from the Faculty of Arts
- 3 units of open electives which can be chosen from any faculty in the University.

Electives can be chosen from the same or different areas of study. Ensure that you check any restrictions and pre-requisites.

*Students are **STRONGLY** advised to seek advice from the Faculty of Sciences when choosing Science Elective courses.
