#### Sociology Course

You must complete 24 units of Sociology Core courses and 9 units of Sociology Closed Electives from the list on page 2. Ensure that you check any restrictions and pre-requisites.

#### International Development Major

The International Development major comprises 24 units. You must complete a minimum of 3 and maximum of 6 units at Level I, a minimum of 3 units at Level II, and at least 12 units at Level III, including the 6-unit designated capstone course.

#### Elective

You must complete 12 units of elective courses chosen from any discipline within the Faculty of Arts. Electives can be from the same or different areas of study. Ensure that you check any restrictions and pre-requisites.

### International Development Major

24 units of courses including: a minimum of 3 units and a maximum of 6 units at level I; a minimum of 3 units at level II; and a minimum 12 units at level III including one capstone course. 15 units must be taken in the major before undertaking the capstone. 6 units may be taken from the cross-listed courses. The simplest way to plan your major is:

- 6 units at level I
- 6 units at level II
- 12 units at level III. This includes the 6 unit capstone course.
