Diploma Information

You must complete 24 units with not more than 6 units at Level I to finish your diploma. Most courses are worth 3 units each, unless specified otherwise.

The language sequence must be completed part-time over a three-year period due to the sequential nature of language teaching and course pre-requisites.

All courses must be studied in the same language. Languages can be studied at beginner's or continuer's level.

The Diploma is only available to students who are concurrently enrolled in a degree at the University of Adelaide.

Credit for University of Adelaide Students

If you are studying a Faculty of Arts degree concurrently with the Diploma in Languages, you may receive up to 12 units of credit towards elective courses in your primary degree.

If you are studying a degree in another faculty, you will need to discuss the possibility of receiving credit from the Diploma toward your primary degree with the relevant faculty office.
