Teaching Requirements

The School of Education offers Curriculum & Methodology courses for both 'English' (year 7-10 English in Australian Schools) and 'Senior English' (year 11 & 12 English in Australian Schools).

- To be eligible for 'English Curriculum & Methodology' students must complete 12 units in English Literature, and to be eligible for 'Senior English Curriculum & Methodology' students must complete 18 units in English Literature.
- For both English and Senior English, students can count 3 units of Non-Literature provided the remaining units are Literature-based.
- The courses students complete to meet requirements for Senior English or English Curriculum and Methodology may also be used towards an English Major or Minor in the Bachelor of Arts.
