PLEASE NOTE

- **Eligibility:** the Diploma is open to domestic students who have completed or are concurrently completing an undergraduate degree.
- **Progression:** you must complete at least 3 units at Level 1 before taking courses at Level 2, 3 units at Level 2 before taking courses at Level 3, and 15 units in the major before taking the capstone course.
- **Academic credit:** if you are studying another degree concurrently with the Diploma in Arts, you can apply to receive up to 12 units of credit in your primary degree, subject to the degree rules. Please seek advice from the relevant Faculty Office who administers your primary degree.
