PROGRAM STRUCTURE

UNITS AND LEVELS	You must complete a total of 72 units of courses, with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>at least</i> 12 units and <i>no more than</i> 30 units of Level 1 courses; • <i>at least</i> 24 units of Level 3 courses.
CORE COURSE	All students must complete a course to the value of 3 units chosen from the Arts Core Competency list
MUSIC MAJOR	You must complete 51 units of Classical Performance and Core Music courses.
ELECTIVES	You must complete a total of 18 units of electives, with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 units of music electives; • 9 units of broadening electives (any non-music course – see below).

PLEASE NOTE

- Classical Performance 1A through to 3B (*) must be undertaken in consecutive semesters/years. Any student who is not enrolled in a Classical Performance course for one year or more will need to re-audition before recommencing.
- Students can only enrol in Music Professional Development courses (^) after attending an audition, usually held during orientation in February. Students will be placed in TWO of the following components: Accompanying, Bella Voce (Females only), Brass Ensemble, Chamber Music, Chamber Music – Piano, Elder Conservatorium Chamber Orchestra, Elder Conservatorium Chorale, Elder Conservatorium Symphony Orchestra, Elder Conservatorium Wind Orchestra, Guitar Ensemble, Keyboard Musicianship, Percussion Ensemble, Rhythm Matters, Words About Music.
- Broadening electives must be courses from any non-music discipline. Courses from another music discipline are not considered broadening electives, with the exception of Music Internships and Music Study Tours.
- Classical Performance 1A through to 3B (*) can also be studied in Advanced mode, subject to skill level. Please contact the program coordinator for advice prior to enrolling.
- A course is usually worth 3 units, with some worth 6, 9 or 12. Information about all courses can be found in Course Planner.
- Some courses have restrictions and/or prerequisites (i.e. other courses you must complete first) - check Course Planner to make sure you meet these, if applicable.
- If you think you might like to undertake an internship or go on exchange, plan early in your degree so you don't miss out.
