### PROGRAM STRUCTURE

<b>UNITS AND LEVELS</b>	<p>You must complete a total of 72 units of courses, with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>at least 12 units and no more than 30 units of Level 1 courses;</li> <li>at least 24 units of Level 3 courses.</li> </ul>
<b>CORE COURSE</b>	All students must complete a course totalling 3 units chosen from the Arts Core Competency list
<b>MUSIC MAJOR</b>	You must complete 54 units of Music Education & Pedagogy and Core Music courses.
<b>ELECTIVES</b>	<p>You must complete a total of 15 units of electives, with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6 units of broadening electives (any non-music course – see below);</li> <li>9 units of music electives.</li> </ul> <p><i>Please note: if you wish to be a classroom teacher, you must use your music elective space to study a second teaching area outside music.</i></p>

### PLEASE NOTE

- Music Education Performance courses (\*) must be taken in consecutive semesters/years. Any student who is not enrolled in a Music Education Performance course for one year or more will need to re-audition before recommencing
- Students can only enrol in Music Education Performance courses (^) after attending an audition, usually held during orientation in February. Students will be placed in TWO of the following components: Accompanying, Bella Voce (Females only), Brass Ensemble, Chamber Music, Chamber Music – Piano, Elder Conservatorium Chamber Orchestra, Elder Conservatorium Chorale, Elder Conservatorium Symphony Orchestra, Elder Conservatorium Wind Orchestra, Guitar Ensemble, Jazz Big Band, Jazz Vocal Ensemble, Latin Ensemble, Keyboard Musicianship, Percussion Ensemble, Rhythm Matters, Rhythm & Reading Ensemble, Words About Music.
- Broadening electives must be courses from any non-music discipline. Courses from another music discipline are not considered broadening electives, with the exception of Music Internships and Music Study Tours.
- A course is usually worth 3 units, with some worth 6, 9 or 12. Information about all courses can be found in Course Planner.
- Some courses have restrictions and/or prerequisites (i.e. other courses you must complete first) - check Course Planner to make sure you meet these, if applicable.
- If you think you might like to undertake an internship or go on exchange, plan early in your degree so you don't miss out.
