

The German Embassy Prize for Outstanding Achievement in German Studies

Establishment

The Prize has been established by a donation to the University from the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany.

Value

The value of the Prize will be determined annually in liaison with the Embassy.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this Prize, students must be enrolled in German Studies courses and doing a German Studies Major in the year for which the Prize is awarded. This includes students enrolled in a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Languages as well as students enrolled for a Diploma of Languages.

Selection of Candidate

The Prize will be awarded by the Head of the Department of German Studies (or nominee) to the student with the most outstanding achievement in a Level III German course (including Translation) containing a research component and an oral presentation.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in any given year then the Prize will not be awarded in that year, and the funds will be retained by the University and used to award it in the following year.

Variations

In consultation with the donor, the University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and policies.
